- (1) The Secretary of State for Education of Sanctuary Buildings, Great Smith Street, London SW1P 3BT (the "Secretary of State") and
- (2) WMG ACADEMY FOR YOUNG ENGINEERS, a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered company number 07937014, whose registered office is at 251 Mitchell Avenue, Coventry, England, CV4 8DY (the "Company"),

together the "Parties".

INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into funding agreements executed as deeds on 5 March 2015 (the "Supplemental Funding Agreements") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of the WMG Academy for Young Engineers (Coventry) and WMG Academy for Young Engineers (Solihull) as Academies in accordance with and supplemented to the Master Funding Agreement between the Secretary of State and the Academy Trust, dated 5 March 2015 ("the Master Funding Agreement").
- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend certain terms and conditions of the Supplemental Funding Agreements in accordance with the terms of this Deed.
- C. This Deed is supplemental to the Master Funding Agreement.

1. INTERPRETATION

1.1 Words, expressions and interpretations used in this Deed shall, unless the context expressly requires otherwise, have the meaning given to them in, and shall be interpreted in accordance with, the Funding Agreement.

2. VARIATION OF THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

2.1 The Parties agree that with effect from the date of this Deed the Supplemental Funding Agreements shall be amended in accordance with Schedule 1 to this Deed.

2.3 Except as varied by this Deed, the Supplemental Funding Agreements shall remain in full force and effect.

3. Governing law and jurisdiction

- 3.1 This Deed, and any disputes or claims arising out of or in connection with it, its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims), shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.
- 3.2 The Parties irrevocably agree that the English courts have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Deed or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).

4. Counterparts

4.1 This Deed may be executed in any number of counterparts and by the parties to it on separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original, but all the counterparts shall together constitute one and the same instrument.

Schedule 1

1. Paragraph 2.H of the Supplemental Funding Agreement shall be replaced with the following new paragraph 2.H:

"2.H The Academy Trust must participate in the local Fair Access Protocol. The Academy Trust must participate in the coordinated admission arrangements operated by the LA in whose area the Academy is situated unless it opts out of doing so in any admissions year by notifying the LA in writing no later than the date or determining its admissions policy for the Academy."
